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1. IMPORTANT DATES

Sunday, July 28: Artwork labels due

Monday, August 12, 4:00 to 8:00 pm: Artwork drop-off at IDES Hall, 22 Stage Rd.

Sign-up for 2 hour hosting slot (sales &/or entry table).

Friday - Friday, August 9-16: Prepare for the show throughout the week.

Committee chairs will contact artists regarding assign-

ments, dates and activities.

Friday, August 16, 5:00 pm: Deliver hors d'oeuvres to the hall kitchen.

Friday, August 16, 6:00 to 9:00 pm: Art Reception. Please be there to greet our guests!

Sunday, August 18, 5:00 pm: Raffle Winners Drawing.

Sunday, August 18, 4:00 pm: Unsold artwork may be taken home.

If your raffle item has not been picked up, you are responsible for arranging delivery to the winner.

Monday, August 19, 11:00 am to 3:00 pm: Take show down. Clean up.

Unsold artwork must be taken home. "Doors" close for good at 3 pm.

2. PRINTED LABEL INFO

Deadline to submit ARTWORK INFO for printed labels is Sunday, July 28th

Label information submitted after the due date will be charged:

\$5 per label up to August 11th.

\$10 per label the week of the show set up.

* Late change requests are not guaranteed. Priority is given to missing labels. Art cannot be displayed without a printed label.

After the Drawing:

9. PREPARATION OF YOUR ART

The Hanging Committee can only accept works on canvas or paper that are framed*, wired and ready to hang.. *Exception for gallery canvases with painted sides.

Artists must provide white pedestals for sculptures, woodwork and ceramics.

Examples:











Please, NO easel back frames or round/triangular metal fittings to fit over Screw heads, no sawtooth hangers.

- Deliver your Art and Raffle Donation to: I..D.E.S. Hall 22 Stage Rd, Pescadero, Monday, August 12th, between 4:00 and 8:00 pm.
- Temporary labels must be attached to the front of each artwork—they will be replaced later in the week with printed labels by the Label Committee.
- We cannot accept any work later than 10 am Wednesday, August 16th.
- Sign up to host the show for a two-hour shift before you leave the hall. We will go over the cashiering process.
- Please note:
 - -Expect to be at the drop-off and check-in for at least a half-hour.
 - -Please come with work framed in advance.
 - -There will be a table with limited framing supplies—first come first serve for repairs, and adjustments.
 - -Every thing must be ready to hang before you leave.
 - -Please take all wrapping materials with you—we have NO storage space and will be unable to keep track of it for you.

10. BIN ART

Exhibitors may display shrink-wrapped art works or greeting cards depicting your work. Art may have been exhibited in previous shows but must be one-of-a-kind or signed, limited-editions.

- Artists should provide their own racks/bins.
- Each artist may have one bin or one card-rack.
- We recommend that you create a list of your bin art for your records.
- Each item including cards must have its own sticker with the price and artist's initials.

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11. ***COMMITTEE SELECTION***

Committee chairs will contact you with dates, times, & shifts.

All exhibiting artists actively participate on one committee. Committee names and description of main duties are described below. We do our best to accommodate your choices.

The committee chair will send more details about your specific committee choice duties, once assigned.

To offer timeline examples or insights:

- Facilities and Installation: Prep for walls and light fixtures, hanging and show installation including labels (most of it happen during the week preceding the art show).
- Reception: Coordination of set up, food, drinks, volunteers, and clean up (some aspects take place during the months preceding the show and some the weekend of the show).
- Kids' Art: Help to obtain and hang art the week preceding art show.
- Sales: Sales Lead duties the weekend of the show.
- Marketing: Publicity, Website, Mailchimp, Design of postcards. It happens months before the show.
- Raffle: Organizing and Delivery. Before, during and after the show.
